Dear Mr. Krug:

This letter is in response to your air quality General Construction Permit (GCP)-4 Initial Registration application dated October 20, 2015 to construct a O&G-Production Facility in New Mexico. The application was received by the Department on October 21, 2015.

A review has been completed and the information provided is sufficient to issue your Initial Registration under GCP-4 in accordance with 20. 2.72.220 NMAC, and the conditions of GCP-4. Your registration number is **6567**; please include this registration number in all subsequent submittals regarding this facility.

Attached is a copy of your GCP-4 Initial Registration application, GCP-4, and the GCP-4 Guidance Document. GCP-4 includes terms and conditions for construction and operation of the facility as well as emissions limits and compliance requirements. Note the facility shall notify the Department at least one working day prior to beginning construction of the facility, and that this notification includes proof of public notice and information regarding facility location. You are also required to notify the Department at least one day prior to beginning operation. Within 10 days of beginning operation, you are required to submit to the Department a Siting Registration Application for the facility. For both notifications and the Siting Registration Application, you are required to use current Department forms.

Pursuant to 20.2.75.11 NMAC, the Department will assess an annual fee for this facility. This regulation set the fee amount at \$1,500 through 2004 and requires it to be adjusted annually for the Consumer Price Index on January 1. The current fee amount is available by contacting the Department or can be found on the Department's website. The AQB will invoice the permittee for the

annual fee amount at the beginning of each calendar year. This fee does not apply to sources which are assessed an annual fee in accordance with 20.2.71 NMAC. For sources that satisfy the definition of "small business" in subsection F of 20.2.75.7 NMAC, this annual fee will be divided by two.

All fees shall be remitted in the form of a corporate check, certified check, or money order made payable to the "NM Environment Department, AQB" mailed to the address shown on the invoice and shall be accompanied by the remittance slip attached to the invoice.
