Notice of Withdrawal from Pre-Filing**

Dear Ms. Reese:

On April 17, 2019, Venture Global Delta LNG, LLC and Venture Global Delta Express, LLC (collectively, “Delta LNG”), both of which are wholly owned subsidiaries of Venture Global LNG, Inc. (“Venture Global LNG”), filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) a Request to Initiate the National Environmental Policy Act (“NEPA”) Pre-filing Review Process for their proposed liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) export and related gas pipeline project (“Delta LNG Project”). On April 30, 2019, Delta LNG received approval from Commission Staff to commence the Pre-filing review process for the Delta LNG Project. Throughout the Pre-filing review process, Delta LNG has diligently engaged with all interested stakeholders, with a particular emphasis on engagement with the local community in Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana—the location of Delta LNG’s proposed LNG export terminal.

Venture Global LNG has subsequently determined that pursuing the Delta LNG Project at this particular time would not be the best use of its corporate resources or the resources of the Commission’s staff; instead, Venture Global LNG has decided to focus its efforts in Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana on its proposed Plaquemines Expansion Project. The Plaquemines Expansion Project was accepted into the Commission’s Pre-filing review process on April 4, 2025 in FERC Docket No. PF25-7-000, and Venture Global LNG expects that, upon completion, the Plaquemines Expansion Project will produce approximately the same quantities of LNG as the proposed Delta LNG Project, but on a faster schedule than the proposed Delta LNG Project.¹ Accordingly, through this letter, Delta LNG is withdrawing the Delta LNG Project from the Commission’s Pre-filing review process.

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Delta LNG sincerely appreciates the work conducted by the Commission staff, federal, state and local agencies and other interested stakeholders on the Delta LNG Project through the Pre-filing review process. The development of the Delta LNG Project has advanced due to these significant efforts, which Delta LNG recognizes will help processing a future review of the Delta LNG Project or other affiliated projects.
