LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY (LDEQ)
SABINE PASS LNG, LP AND SABINE PASS LIQUEFACTION, LLC
SABINE PASS LNG TERMINAL
PROPOSED PART 70 AIR OPERATING PERMIT RENEWAL & MODIFICATION

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services, is accepting written comments on the Proposed Part 70 Air Operating Permit Renewal and Modification for Sabine Pass LNG, LP and Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC, 9243 Gulf Beach Highway, Cameron, Louisiana 70631 for the Sabine Pass LNG Terminal. **The facility is located at 9243 Gulf Beach Highway, Cameron, Cameron Parish.**

Sabine Pass LNG, LP and Sabine Pass Liquefaction, LLC requested a Part 70 Air Operating Permit Renewal for the Sabine Pass LNG terminal and the following changes:

1. Reconcile power output of Natural Gas-Fired Generator Turbine Nos. 1 through 8 (EQT0003 through EQT0006, EQT0084, EQT0085, EQT0119, and EQT0120) based on as-built operating parameters. Emission limits for the turbines are being updated accordingly. SO₂ emission limits for the generator turbines are also being updated based on the sulfur content of 0.002 gr/dscf in natural gas fuel;
2. Incorporate the Standby Diesel Generator Engine No. 13 (EQT0192), which was previously authorized under Regulatory Permit RP_119267_PER20240005, dated July 22, 2024; and the Firewater Pump Diesel Engine No. 4 (EQT0194), which was previously authorized under Regulatory Permit RP_119267_PER20250003, dated May 2, 2025;
3. Update emission limits and applicable requirements for the Truck Loading Operation (EQT0098) based on updated emission factors;
4. Update emission limits for the thermal oxidizers (EQT0092 through EQT0095, EQT0123, and EQT0124) to include thermal NO_x emissions;
5. Update greenhouse gas emissions from all combustion sources to reflect the updated Global Warming Potential (GWP) of 40 CFR 98 Subpart A;
6. Incorporate applicable requirements of 40 CFR 63 Subpart YYYY for the combustion turbines, based on the March 9, 2022, amendment;
7. Replace the Wet / Dry Gas Flares and Thermal Oxidizers Group (GRP0009) and the Marine Flares Group (GRP0010) with the Flares and Thermal Oxidizers Group (GRP0012) to provide operational flexibility;
8. Reconcile/Update applicable requirements for the Standby Diesel Generator Engines;
9. Update the description of all Train 6 refrigeration compressor turbines from "... (36TC-..." to "... (46TC-...";
10. Incorporate various storage tanks/vessels (EQT0177 through EQT0191), which were previously authorized as Insignificant Activities per LAC 33:III.501.B.5.D;
11. Reconcile the thermal oxidizers' DRE from 99.99% to 99.9% for benzene; and
12. Update General Condition XVII Activities and Insignificant Activities lists to reflect the current terminal conditions and the addition of six solvent injection skids.

This permit was processed as an expedited permit in accordance with LAC 33:I.Chapter 18.

Any remarks received during the technical review will be addressed in the "Worksheet for Technical Review of Working Draft of Proposed Permit". All remarks received by LDEQ are included in the record that is available for public review.
