Dear Mr. Musser:

I grant your request for Venture Global Calcasieu Pass, LLC (Venture Global) to place in-service the remainder of the facilities at the Calcasieu Pass LNG Terminal as described in your March 25, 2025 filing. Your request is consistent with Conditions 12, 31, and 103-107 of the Commission's February 21, 2019 *Order Granting Authorizations Under Sections 3 and 7 of the Natural Gas Act* (Order) in the above-referenced docket. This approval is based on FERC staff inspections and review of the information filed on March 25, 2025.

Based on Commission staff inspections and review of the commissioning and remediation activities, Venture Global has demonstrated that the above-mentioned facilities have been constructed in accordance with Commission approval and applicable standards and can be expected to operate safely and reliably as designed. Further, based on Commission staff inspections and Venture Global's recent construction status reports, I note that Venture Global has adequately stabilized the areas disturbed by construction and that restoration of the areas affected by the approved facilities are proceeding satisfactorily.

I remind you that Venture Global must comply with all applicable remaining terms and conditions of the above referenced Orders. We also note that Venture Global must also comply with any applicable Department of Transportation requirements under 49 CFR 193 subject to Department of Transportation Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration enforcement. Similarly, Venture Global must comply with any

applicable U.S. Coast Guard requirements under 33 CFR 127 and 33 CFR 105 subject to U.S. Coast Guard enforcement.

Furthermore, we note that FERC staff look to continuously evaluate the safety and reliability of LNG facilities through its technical reviews and inspections, which may result in recommendations. If you have any questions regarding this approval, please contact John Lesser at (202) 502-8012.
