**PUBLIC HEARING AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON A PROPOSED PART 70 AIR**  
**OPERATING PERMIT, PSD PERMIT, THE ASSOCIATED ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STATEMENT**

The LDEQ, Office of Environmental Services will conduct a public hearing to receive comments on the Part 70 air operating permit, PSD permit, and the associated Environmental Assessment Statement (EAS) for Plaquemines Liquids Terminal, LLC, 370 Van Gordon Street, Lakewood, CO 80228 for the Plaquemines Liquids Terminal. **The facility is located at right descending bank of the Mississippi River at Mile Marker 61 in the Myrtle Grove area in Plaquemines Parish.**

**The public hearing will be conducted as a joint public hearing with the Department of Natural Resources for a coastal use permit associated with the facility.**

The hearing will be held **on Tuesday, February 6, 2020, beginning at 6:00 p.m., at the 8398 Hwy 23, Belle Chasse, LA 70037.** During the hearing, all interested persons will have an opportunity to present oral statements, views, recommendations, opinions and information on the proposed permits. Additionally, written statements and other documents such as charts, data, and tabulations may be filed with the hearing officer at the hearing.

Plaquemines Liquids Terminal, LLC requested authorization to construct and operate a bulk liquid export terminal.

**This permit was processed as an expedited permit in accordance with LAC 33:I.Chapter 18.**

Permitted emissions of criteria pollutants from the facility, in tons per year (TPY), are as follows:

A working draft of the proposed permit was submitted to the facility representative. Any remarks received during the technical review will be addressed in the “Worksheet for Technical Review of Working Draft of Proposed Permit”. All remarks received by LDEQ are included in the record that is available for public review.

The EAS submitted by the applicant addresses avoidance of potential and real environmental effects, balancing of social and economic benefits against environmental impact costs, and alternative sites, projects, and mitigative measures.

The public hearing will be conducted in accordance with La. R.S. 30:2017, which addresses the authority of the hearing officer and provides for the order in which speakers will be allowed to speak. A hearing officer will preside over the public hearing. This will be a formal hearing for the purpose of gathering facts and information. It will not include a “question and answer” component. In accordance with La. R.S. 30:2016, the hearing will be transcribed and become a part of the official public record.

Comments and requests for a public hearing or notification of the final LDEQ permit decision can be submitted via personal delivery, U.S. mail, email, or fax. **Comments and requests for public hearings must be received by 4:30 pm CST, Monday, February 11, 2020.** Delivery may be made to the drop-box at 602 N. 5<sup>th</sup> St., Baton Rouge, LA 70802. A written response to all public comments will be prepared at the time of the final permit decision. LDEQ will send notification of the final permit decision to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or a written request for notification of the final decision.
